## You can give the gift of... Education

Training workshops were held at a Polio Centre in Southern India. Unlike many of her disabled peers, 7-year-old Bathana attended school. However, the school just fed her a meal and then sent her home — she didn't receive an education! As a result of our Integr8 team's training, local teachers are now more aware of how to provide children like Bathana with appropriate activities.





Our Integr8 training in Guatemala enabled teachers at Life and Hope School to welcome disabled children for the first time.





Sharon, a nine-year old girl living in Kimilili, Kenya, is severely disabled by tuberculosis of the spine. As well as a wheelchair, our Wheels for the World team were able to give Sharon a classroom chair with a tray so she can practice writing and take part in school activities.

#### The Gospel





### What can I do to raise funds for Through the Roof?

#### Sponsored run, cycle, walk...
